NOTES:

Typical LL.M. Fall semester course load is 3 courses (1 mandatory + 2 or 3 electives, total 9 credits). Highlighted courses are required of all LL.M. students, as noted. A load of more than 9 credits is considered an overload and is permitted only with approval of the Program Chair and requires payment of additional tuition fees for such overload credits.
